### Fee Payment Schedule

**All fees and forms are to be turned in to your pack camp chairperson**

January 6-April 11 Early Bird registrations \$20 per Scout (**non-refundable**)

April 11 Early Bird deadline: Fees, health forms, copies of parent's insurance card (front & back), & attendance rosters are due in the Scout Service Center

April 11 Campership forms due

April 12-2 weeks before camp: Regular fee reservations accepted (**non-refundable**)

**Final payment of regular camp fees, rosters and health forms (A & B) are due to a CAC Scout Service Center at least 2 weeks prior to your scheduled camp date.**
