GUIDELINES OF FACILITY USE FOR  
CROSSROADS OF AMERICA COUNCIL  
SCOUT EDUCATION AND PROGRAM CENTER

The facilities available at the Scout Education and Program Center are provided by the council to support district activities and council events. The facilities are a large financial obligation of service by our council. Enjoy the facilities, protect them, conserve and give everyone the chance to enjoy a Scouting adventure.

FOR RENTAL:

- Contact any council service center to begin the reservation process. Once it has been determined that the facilities are available for rental, this rental form will be completed. Your district executive or council activity advisor will be contacted to oversee the use of the facility.
- A small usage fee is charged to cover normal wear and tear to the building. A security deposit is charged to cover any possible damage, loss and general cleaning charges. This is refunded if the facility is left in good condition, cleaned according to guidelines, and the building is properly secured at the end of the rental.
- The rental fee includes use of any audio visual or technical equipment in the room, providing a person who has completed the council's audio/visual training will be present. For more information about the a/v equipment and training, contact the council service center.
- The warming kitchenette may only be used if it has been reserved. There is a possibility that smaller groups may be asked to share the kitchenette.
- All groups are asked to use only those facilities that have been reserved, confirmed, and paid for with the completion of this form. Should it be found that additional facilities were used by your group during the course of your rental, additional charges may be incurred.
- No reservation is considered confirmed until confirmed directly by the Scout Education and Program Center Customer Service Representative and a completed copy of this Facility Rental Permit has been returned to the renter.

GENERAL USAGE GUIDELINES:

- All groups will return the facility to the same or better state and condition as it was found. **Procedures for cleaning and resetting the facilities are posted in each conference room.** A copy of these procedures will be provided ahead of the rental upon request.
- Groups are responsible for the cleaning and condition of other areas of the facility used by their group members beyond what may have been reserved.
- Groups are responsible for any missing items or damage done to facilities or equipment. Any damage will be charged to the group at the cost of repair or replacement.
- The fireplace in Scout Hall may only be used at council events with council employees present. The fire ring in the amphitheater may only be used if the amphitheater has been reserved.
- Do not hang anything on the conference room walls. Use the provided tack strips and white boards for any displays.
- Smoking is not allowed in the Scout Education and Program Center or its grounds. A smoking area is located on the south side of the building outside the training wing door near the kitchenette.
- No alcohol or illegal drugs are allowed on any Scout property.
- No firearms, weapons or fireworks are allowed on any Scout property.
- Park all vehicles in the provided parking lots.
- Pets are prohibited in the Scout Education and Program Center and its grounds.

RENTERS PLEASE SIGN BELOW TO INDICATE - WE UNDERSTAND THAT:

- Reservations and a permit are required for any use of council properties. Please allow six (6) working days notice before you wish to use the facility. (PLEASE - no reservations will be accepted with less than six working days notice.)
- Day use of buildings is provided free of charge to all council/district sponsored meetings.
- Other facilities are rented on an "as requested" basis.

**Rental fees are very nominal – (thanks to F.O.S. and United Way support) – but are important to the upkeep of the building, equipment, and grounds.**

LASTLY

All activities in council facilities must be designed to be a positive contribution to the training and growth of every youth, using the proven purpose and methods of the Boy Scouts of America. We understand that the "Scout Oath and Scout Law" are the real traditions of our facilities and are the responsibility of every adult leader (volunteer or professional) to demonstrate by their own personal example. We are all responsible to "leave a council facility better than I found it" - please report any damage. We realize that it is our personal responsibility to replace or repair property or equipment damage that we incur.
