## DAN BEARD 2013

Dan Beard Camp is designed for younger Scouts who are working toward the rank of First Class. Scouts will have the opportunity to complete various requirements towards the ranks of Tenderfoot, Second Class and First Class. This camp will emphasize the major skills needed in those three ranks. Scouts attending Dan Beard will also earn the First Aid merit badge and Camper, the first rank of Firecrafter.

Dan Beard Camp is located at Belzer Day Camp on the northeast side of Indianapolis. The camp operates Monday through Thursday from 8:45 AM to 3:00 PM. The cost is \$75.00 per four day session. Please note that there are no refunds on Dan Beard registrations, but the fee is transferable to another Scout or may be used for a different week of camp (if available) during the summer of 2013.
