Fact Sheet

Concept: One of Scouting's methods of youth development includes wearing a uniform. The Scout uniform makes Scouting visible as a force for good, signifies the Scout's commitment to Scouting ideals and serves as an economic equalizer of all boys. Additionally, a Scout earns advancement by completing the various requirements from the Scout handbook.

Background: Recognizing the essential role of the uniform and handbook in Scout programs, the Lilly Endowment has offered funds to support this Program Assistance for Scouts who would not otherwise be able to purchase one or both of these items.

How the Program

Works:

- 1) The unit leader certifies the Scout has qualified by:
 - a. Being active in the unit for one month.OR
 - b. Has earned one rank advancement (defined as: Tiger, Bobcat, Wolf, Bear, Webelos, Arrow of Light, Tenderfoot, 2nd Class, 1st Class, Star, Life or Eagle).
- 2) The Scout presents the completed application, with signatures, and his payment of \$15 to one of the Scout Service Centers.
