Fans in attendance will be randomly selected to win national semifinal and championship game tickets throughout the day!! ## **NCAA® Final Four Dribble®**

**Date:** Sunday, April 4

**Location:** Start: NCAA national office (White River State Park)

Finish: Indiana Convention Center (corner of West and Maryland)

**Admission:** Free to the 3,000 participants to register.

**Time:** Dribble begins at 3 p.m. All participants, including pre-registered, must check-in prior to 2:30 p.m.

**Registration:** On-line registration available to the first 2,000 registrants coming soon. Log on to [www.NCAA.com/finalfour](http://www.NCAA.com/finalfour) for details. On-site registration will also be available from 11 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. on the day of the event at the start location.

**Description:**

- The Scouts have the opportunity to lead the way as thousands of Indiana youth open up this special event by dribbling basketballs through the streets of downtown Indianapolis. Scouts will have the opportunity to be the first to sign-up through an early sign-up period and receive a free basketball, t-shirt, complimentary admission into Bracket Town and the NCAA Hall of Champions for participating.
- Also regarding parents/chaperones at the dribble:
  - Dribblers under 12 years old must be accompanied by an adult.
  - Registration and Waiver of Liability must be completed by a PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN prior to a child's participation.
  - Parents with strollers are permitted; Pets are not allowed.

### Cup Holder Stickers:

In preparation of the big games, we will need Scouts, leaders and parents to assist in placing stickers on all of the cup holders that are attached to each seat in Lucas Oil Stadium. After the Champions have torn down the nets, volunteer assistance will also be required to remove these stickers. - Saturday March 27th @ 1:00pm - Cup Holder Sticker Coverage (LOS) - estimate this will probably go til 4-5pm
- Friday April 9th @ 4:30pm – Cup Holder Sticker Removal (LOS) – estimate this will probably go til 7pm

Two Days of Service- Thursday, April 1st and Friday, April 2nd

Each of the 71,000 basketball fans attending the national semifinal games on Saturday, April 3 will take home a commemorative seat cushion. With your assistance in placing these cushions in the seats on the evenings of Thursday, April 1 and Friday, April 2, you will have the opportunity to take home one a seat cushion as a memento of Final Four history. Additionally, all volunteers will receive a free NCAA Final Four Circuit of Fun Patch!
