What is NYLT?

National Youth Leadership Training is an exciting, action-packed program designed to provide youth members of the Boy Scouts of America with leadership skills and experience they can use in their home units and in other situations demanding leadership of self and others.

Course Overview:

The NYLT course centers around the concepts of what a leader must **BE**, what a leader must **KNOW**, and what a leader must **DO**. The key elements are then taught with a clear focus on **HOW TO**. The skills come alive during the week as the team goes on a *Quest for the Meaning of Leadership*.

NYLT is a six-day course, patterned after a month in the life of a unit. Content is delivered in a group and team outdoor setting with an emphasis on immediate application of learning in a fun environment.

The NYLT course integrates the best of modern leadership theory with the traditional strengths of the Scouting experience. Through activities, presentations, challenges, discussions, and audio-visual support, NYLT participants will be engaged in a unified approach to leadership that will give them the skills and confidence to lead well. Through a wide range of activities, events, games, and adventures, NYLT participants will work and play together as they put into action the best that Scouting has to offer.

The Stages of Team Development:

During an NYLT course, team members find themselves going through the stages of team development. Their challenges heighten the team development process, enabling them to use their awareness of the stages to build a highly effective team that can reach its full potential. Along the way they also enjoy the Scouting fellowship and fun that are key components of the team method

Vision, Goals and Planning:

NYLT participants discover that leading themselves and leading others requires a vision—a picture of future success. Each team will develop a team vision for the course, and each individual will prepare his or her own vision. A constant refrain of NYLT is "If you can see it, you can be it." Through presentations and positive experiences in goal setting, planning, and problem solving, participants learn how to set a clear course toward realizing their team and individual visions, and then how to put themselves in the center of those pictures of future success.

Code of Ethics:

Every NYLT course operates according to the principles of the Scout Oath, Law, Venture Oath, and Code. Each participant and staff member is welcomed, appreciated, and valued. There is no room for hazing or for any activities that do not add to a positive learning experience for everyone.

Have Fun:

Leadership, fun, challenge, adventure—NYLT offers all of those and much more. The NYLT program is the centerpiece of this council's youth training opportunities, providing local units with outstanding youth leaders and giving those participants the tools and leadership ideals that will serve them well in whatever they do.

Who should attend NYLT?

Any participant who is currently holding a key leadership role in their home unit or the unit leader feels has the potential to hold a key leadership position in the future. Along with the unit leaders approval the participant must be 13 years old as of the first day of course. NYLT is required for a youth to staff a Kodiak Challenge course.

What is the involvement of the

Unit Leader:

NYLT is intended to strengthen the relationship between the youth leader and unit leader. The unit leader is highly encouraged to have a pre-course and post-course conference with the participant to discuss their vision and goals for future success of their home unit.

When and where is it held?

NYLT is held twice a year.

The first session is from June 9-15, 2013

The second session is from July 14-20, 2013

What is the cost of the program?

Fees for the course are \$175.00 per participant and include all food and materials. Early Bird fees for the course are \$160.00 if paid 30 days prior to the start of attended session.

June session early bird cutoff is May 9, 2013

July session early bird cutoff is June 14, 2013

A deposit of \$25.00 per participant should accompany the reservation form to hold a spot. The balance of payment is due by the dates above to receive the early bird fee otherwise the \$175 will be due prior to the course. participant may wish to bring a small amount of spending money for the NYLT trading post.

The trading post will only be opened with limited merchandise on the first day of course and the full trading post will be available on the last day of the course.

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
