The Thomas W. Moses Good Scout Award:

2019 Honorees: Nancy and Bobby “Slick” Leonard

This award is presented to an individual who has made a significant contribution to our community, state, or nation, and who exemplifies Scouting values.

The Whitney M. Young, Jr. Award:

2019 Honoree: Tanya Bell

This is a national award recognizing outstanding contributions and services by an adult, individual, or organization in the development and support of Scouting programs for all young people.... regardless of socioeconomic, cultural differences, circumstance, or disability.

Silver Beaver Award:

2019 Honorees: 11 Recipients chosen by the Silver Beaver Awards Committee

The Silver Beaver Award was introduced in 1931 and is a council-level distinguished service award of the Boy Scouts of America. Recipients of this award are registered Scouters who have made an impact on the lives of youth through service given to the Crossroads of America Council.
