Program Policies

Organizations that charter Scouting units agree to use the Scouting program in accordance of their own policies as well as those of the BSA. The program is flexible, but major departures from BSA methods and policies are not permitted. As a parent, you should be aware that:
• Leadership is restricted to qualified adults who subscribe to the precepts of the Declaration of Religious Principle, the Scout Oath, the Scout Law, and the BSA Standards of Leadership.
• Citizenship activities are encouraged, but partisan political activities are prohibited.
• Military training drills are prohibited.
• Marksmanship and elementary drill for ceremonies are permitted.
• The Boy Scouts of America recognizes the importance of faith and duty; it leaves sectarian religious instruction to the member's religious leaders and family.
• Members who do not belong to a unit's religious chartered organization shall not be required to participate in it's religious activities.
• Two registered adult leaders or one registered adult leader and a parent of a participant, one of whom is 21 years of age or older, are required on all trips and outings.
• If trips and outings are coeducational, leaders of both genders must be present.
• Corporal punishment and hazing are not permitted.
• Parents and unit leaders must work together to solve discipline problems.
• One-on-one activities between youth members and adults are not permitted; personal conferences must be conducted in plain view of others.
• If you suspect that anyone in the unit is a victim of child abuse, immediately contact the Scout Executive, who is responsible for reporting this to the appropriate authorities.
• All Scouting activities are open to parental visitation. There are no "secret" organizations within the Boy Scouts of America.

Declaration of Religious Principal

The Boy Scouts of America maintains that no member can grow into the best kind of citizen without recognizing an obligation to God and, therefore, recognizes the religious element in the training of the member, but it is absolutely nonsectarian in its attitude toward that religious training. Its policy is that the home and organization or group with which the member is connected shall give definite attention to religious life. Only persons willing to subscribe to these precepts of the Declaration of Religious Principle and to the Bylaws of the Boy Scouts of America shall be entitled to certificates of membership.

Policy of Nondiscrimination

Youth membership in the Boy Scouts of America is open to all youth and young adults who meet the joining requirements. Membership is Scouting, advancement, and achievement of leadership in Scouting units are open to all youth without regard to race or ethnic background and are based entirely upon individual merit.

### Políticas del programa

Las organizaciones autorizadas se comprometen a usar el programa Scouting conforme a sus propias políticas, así como aquéllas de BSA. El programa es flexible, pero no se permiten desviaciones considerables de los métodos y políticas de BSA. Como padre de familia, usted debe estar consciente de que: • El registro de participantes adultos en BSA está restringido solamente para personas calificadas que están de acuerdo con los preceptos de la Declaración del principio religioso, el Juramento Scout, la Ley Scout y las Normas de liderazgo BSA. Se fomentan las actividades cívicas, pero se prohíben las actividades políticas partidistas. • El entrenamiento y ejercicio militar están prohibidos. Se permiten las prácticas de puntería y ejercicios elementales para las ceremonias. • Si bien Boy Scouts of America reconoce la importancia de la fe y el deber religiosos, la enseñanza de prácticas religiosas es responsabilidad de los líderes religiosos y la familia del miembro. • Aquellos miembros que no pertenecen a la organización autorizada religiosa de una unidad, no tendrán la obligación de participar en sus actividades religiosas.

### Extracto de la Declaración del principio religioso

Boy Scouts of America sostiene que ningún miembro puede convertirse en un ciudadano modelo si no reconoce su obligación hacia Dios y por lo tanto, reconoce el elemento religioso en la capacitación del miembro, pero es absolutamente no sectaria en su actitud hacia dicho desarrollo religioso. Su política es que el hogar y la organización o grupo a los cuales los miembros están vinculados, deberán proporcionar atención precisa a su vida religiosa. Solo las personas dispuestas a apearse a estos preceptos de la Declaración del principio religioso y a los Reglamentos y códigos de Boy Scouts of America, tendrán derecho a certificados de membresía.
