- The cost is \$15 / participant and includes Patch, Camping and awards.

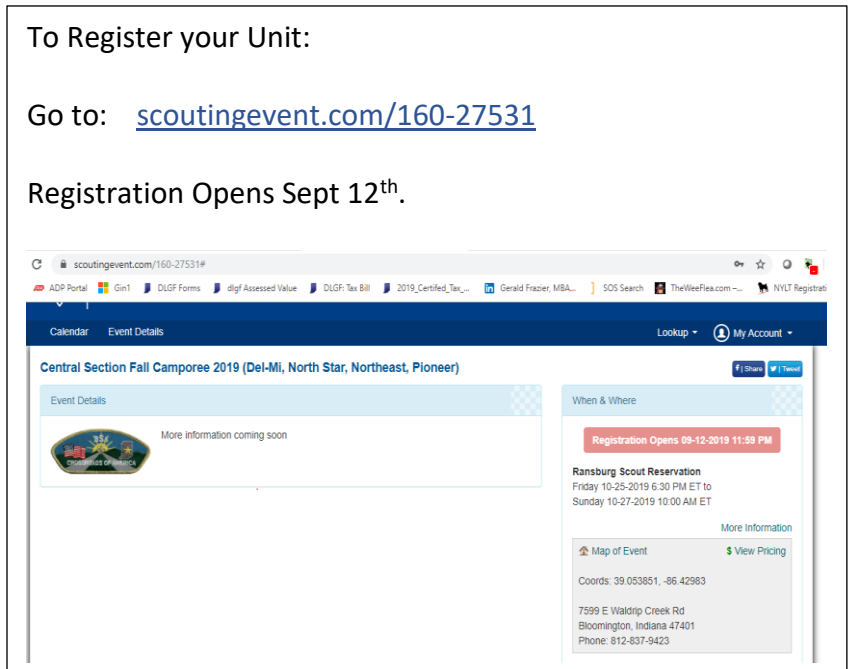
