FRI/SAT CHILD (0 – 16) PACKAGE

This package is valid for Friday night camping and Saturday admission. It should only be paired with the Fri/Sat adult ticket package. Price: \$15.00.

FRI/SAT ADULT (17+) PACKAGE

This package is valid for Saturday admission and Friday evening camping. It should only be paired with the Fri/Sat child ticket package. Package price is \$35 per adult.

SATURDAY CHILD (0 – 16) PACKAGE

This package is valid for Saturday admission. It should only be paired with the Saturday adult ticket package. Price: \$10.00.

SATURDAY ADULT (17+) PACKAGE

This package is valid for Saturday admission and parking. It should only be paired with the Saturday child ticket package. Package price is \$20 per adult.

SUNDAY CHILD (0 – 16) PACKAGE

This package is valid for Sunday admission. It should only be paired with the Sunday adult ticket package. Price: \$10.00.

SUNDAY ADULT (17+) PACKAGE

This package is valid for Sunday admission and parking. It should only be paired with the Sunday child ticket package. Package price is \$30 per adult.

BSA Registration

All youth and adults attending must be currently registered with the BSA and all adults must have a valid youth protection training.

Security

Campsites should never be left unsupervised while Scouts are present. Defacing or damaging buildings or equipment is strictly prohibited. Alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, firearms, flares, knives of any kind, axes, and bows and arrows are strictly prohibited. Pets are only allowed in lot 2 if they remain on a leash. Smoking is not permitted where Scouts may be present. Violators will be removed from the property.

Parking

The parking for Scouts is next to the camping area in Lot 2. A parking pass will be required. Parking passes will be mailed to you with your tickets. The Safety Patrol will be present to make sure that your vehicles are aligned for maximum parking capacity and that your vehicles are out of the way of IMS service vehicles. Please have your car locked when not using it.

Arrival at IMS


Troops will be camping out on the infield, behind the Museum in Lot 2. Upon arrival, the "Yellow Shirts" will direct you to your assigned location where your troop can set-up for the weekend.

Campsite

The area that is designated for camping is Lot 2. Please see map below. Each troop will bring their own tents and a 6x8 box trailer (not all troops will have a trailer). Showers are available for purchase in Lot 2. Each shower visit is \$6. See camping amenities link below for the shower schedule. Within that area, there is no assigned sites for specific units, but they must keep their tents neatly close together and uniform, so there remains room for everyone to enjoy it.

Restrooms

There are no permanent restrooms in Lot 2, but there will be port-o-lets available.

Electricity

There is no electricity in the camping area, but there are charging areas around the stands.

Campfires

Campfires are allowed in the outside lots but are required to be above ground (in a fire pit). We request that the ashes are not dumped once the fire is extinguished.

Food

Units are permitted to bring their own food and cooking stoves to cook for themselves but are not permitted to sell it. Food vendors will be available during the event hours and throughout the Speedway.

Inclement Weather

During gate hours, troops should follow the directions provided by IMS. Post-gate hours, troops should plan to implement their own personal safety plans.
