- set-up folding chairs in your assigned area;
- mark seat numbers for those chairs according to the provided seating chart;
- assist the public with tickets in finding their seats;
- following the parade, tear down and re-stack the chairs for pick-up after the parade; and
- designate someone not to leave until your Troop has your patches and our count is turned in.

Each Scout and Scouter will receive a patch from the Indy 500 Festival Committee and the Troop will receive a certificate of appreciation from the CAC Parade Committee. Plus, you get to watch the parade for free!
