



2018-2019 Northeast District Eagle Project Approval Process Eagle Boards of Review Schedule



Project Concept Approval: Eagle Scout Service Projects (in the Oct 2015 printing of BSA 512-927) may be approved on the first Sunday of the month (except January & July) between 3:30 and 4:00 p.m. at the Golden-Burke Scout Center (7125 Fall Creek Road North, Indianapolis, IN 46256) **or** by special appointment with Northeast District Eagle Processing Chair Jim Imel.

Scouts must call or email District Eagle Processing Chair Jim Imel before bringing their project concept for review on the first Sunday of the month. **No walk-ins.** Mr. Imel may be reached at [317] 823-8103 or at eyemel2@comcast.net.

Remember that **before** the District Advancement Committee can review the project concept for signature, it must be approved and signed by four specific people: (1) yourself, (2) the benefitting community organization representative, (3) your Unit Leader (Scoutmaster or Crew Advisor), and (4) your Unit Committee Chair.

Eagle Rank Application (1/2" to 1") Binder (marked with name, Troop #, and Northeast District) must contain:

- Completed latest (2017) printing of the Eagle Rank Application (BSA 512-728) with all required signatures. The Unit is responsible for checking the accuracy of all dates;
- Completed latest (2015) printing of the Eagle Scout Service Project Workbook (BSA 512-927) with all required signatures;
- The Statement of Ambitions and Life Purpose;
- A list of leadership positions held, honors & awards received, and school and extracurricular activities;
- Council "Eagle Candidate Form" from three references. (Must be **mailed** to: Crossroads of America Council, Northeast District Advancement Committee, (Eagle Candidate's name), 7125 Fall Creek Road North, Indianapolis, IN 46256-3167. Allow enough time to arrive several days **before the Board of Review.**

Binder Approval: Completed Eagle binders must be received and approved at the Golden-Burke Scout Service Center (Eagle Facilitator) no later than the **15th of the month**. You must get a receipt for the binder (no drop-offs). It is the Scout's responsibility to arrange for the binder to be taken to the Service Center for Council approval **after all unit approvals are completed**. The Service Center will keep the approved binders and notify the District Eagle Processing Chair. **The District Eagle Processing Chair (Jim Imel) will then contact the Scout to confirm the date for his Northeast District Eagle Board of Review.**

It is helpful, but not required, for the Scout to bring a second or third copy of his Eagle binder to the Board of Review, and it is *highly recommended* that only *copies* of merit badge cards, advancement cards, or certificates be included in the binder. The **only** original documents that **must** be in the binder are the **Eagle Rank Application** and the **Eagle Leadership Project Workbook** with the required original signatures.

Eagle Boards of Review are held at Golden-Burke Scout Center (7125 Fall Creek Road North) at 4:00 p.m. on the first Sunday of the month except January & July (subject to change) or Holidays.

Board of Review Day: It is highly suggested, but not required, that Eagle candidates be in **full Class A uniform**. They should wear their merit badge sash, but not the OA sash. **They must have their Scout Handbook. The Scoutmaster, or a designated Scouter, must come and introduce their Scout to the Board of Review.**

An Eagle Board of Review is allowed to review any aspect of the Scout's experience including, but not limited to, the Eagle Project, the Oath, the Law, the Outdoor Code, parts of the badge, knots, leadership experiences, Scout Spirit, etc.
