

Details

Almost there. YPT is in four modules. In order to begin, you must click the **course name or the **arrow** on the right for each section. Once you finish with one, begin with the next. Begin at top and work your way down to the test.**

Each section contains unskippable sections. Training takes approx 70-75 minutes if you are paying attention. You can't leave and come back, there are click-prompts to make sure you are chained to your desk. The training may occasionally log you out but it will save the progress you have made.

There is a 25 question test at the end.




