



## Request for Certificate of General Liability Insurance

Units may request a Certificate of Insurance from our council. This is a document that gives evidence that the BSA has insurance to cover the claims for which they may be responsible. A Certificate of Insurance can only be issued for an authorized BSA activity. For unit fundraising activities, a unit fundraising application must also be filed and approved.
