### New This Year: Overnight Camping Option

This campout opportunity is for Scouts BSA Units of 10+ people who complete a Good Turn for Nature service project with a minimum of 4 work hours. The unit will receive a 'pay one night, get one night free' camping at the host site where the service project is conducted.

*In partnership with the Indiana DNR, select state parks are offering this option.*

Note: Camping options may be provided for Cub Scout units who would like to do bigger projects, but the criteria of 10+ people and a minimum of 4 work hours remains the same. Younger aged groups will be required to contact the host site to work out project details.
